

## How do we do it?



Tires received at our plant will be beneficially reused as a tire derived aggregate (TDA). TDA is an engineered product made by cutting scrap tires into 3 to 5 millimeter pieces. We utilize a low speed high torque shredder capable of processing over 900 passenger tires per hour. TDA can be used for various geotechnical and construction applications such as; highway embankments, backfill of retaining walls, bridge abutments, drainage layers and gas systems, alternative daily cover for sanitary landfills, septic field systems, highway edge drains. All offsite beneficial use's of TDA receive prior approval from a state regulatory agency.
